2.	Select the Login button	Login screen appears		
3.	Enter username and password (Veteran will login using DSLogon UN/PW) (If using DEMO environment, use mock patient name and PW: pass)	Button will change to Logout when you are logged in, name of the logged in user will be in the lower right part of the screen		
4.	If accessing the app for the first time, user is displayed Right Of Access form	Right of Access form is displayed

13.	Click in the From date field	From date selection Calendar is displayed		
14.	Select From date from Calendar	Date selected is displayed in the From field		
15.	Click in the To date field	To date selection Calendar is displayed		
16.	Select To date from Calendar	Date selected is displayed in the To field		
17.	Select Add	The date range is displayed in the left pane as filter/link under 2 years		
18.	Mouse-over and select the date range filter/link from the left pane	(1) The left panel expands and the following domains display: Contact Information, Medical Diagnosis, Allergies, Medications, Surgeries, Vitals, Medication History, Lab Results, Radiology Exams (2) Duration button is displayed (3) All button is displayed in the left pane		
19.	Mouse-over the domain/links in left pane	Domain/link is highlighted when it is moused-over		
20.	Select domain/link using the checkbox from left panel (Multiple selections can be made)	(1) Check is displayed in box (2) Details for the domain are displayed in the right panel under Confidential information. (3) Domain details in the right panel are displayed in the same order as the domains in the left panel (4) PDF button is no longer grayed out

21.	Click duration, then select 1 year filter/link	(1) The left panel expands and the following domains display under 1 year: Contact Information, Medical Diagnosis, Allergies, Medications, Surgeries, Vitals, Medication History, Lab Results, Radiology Exams (2) Duration button is displayed (3) All button is displayed in the left pane		
22.	Mouse-over the domain/links in left pane	Domain/link is highlighted when it is moused-over		
23.	Select domain/link using the checkbox from left panel (Multiple selections can be made)	(1) Check is displayed in box (2) Details for the domain are displayed in the right panel under Confidential information. (3) Domain details in the right panel are displayed in the same order as the domains in the left panel (4) PDF button is no longer grayed out		
24.	Select PDF button	PDF is opened and contains details for all domains selected with Confidential information at the top

25.	Unselect all domains/links	(1) My Mobile Blue Button Report Confidential information is visible in the right pane (2) PDF button is grayed out		
26.	Repeat step #22-25 selecting different combinations of domains			
27.	Select All button	(1) Check is displayed in all domain boxes (2) Details for all domains are displayed in the right panel under Confidential information. (3)Domain details in the right panel are displayed in the same order as the domains in the left panel (4) PDF button is no longer grayed out		
28.	Select None button	(1) Check is removed from all domain boxes (1) My Mobile Blue Button Report Confidential information is visible in the right pane (2) PDF button is grayed out		
29.	Select Duration button from left pane	(1) The domains in the left pane no longer display (2) Left pane shows 1 Year and 2 Year and custom range entered previously

30.	Repeat steps #21-29 using the 2 year filter/link			
<b>Browser Compatibility</b>				
31.	Not supported Browser message	Using a non-supported browser causes the user to be notified of incompatibility and directed to upgrade/switch to a supported browser
