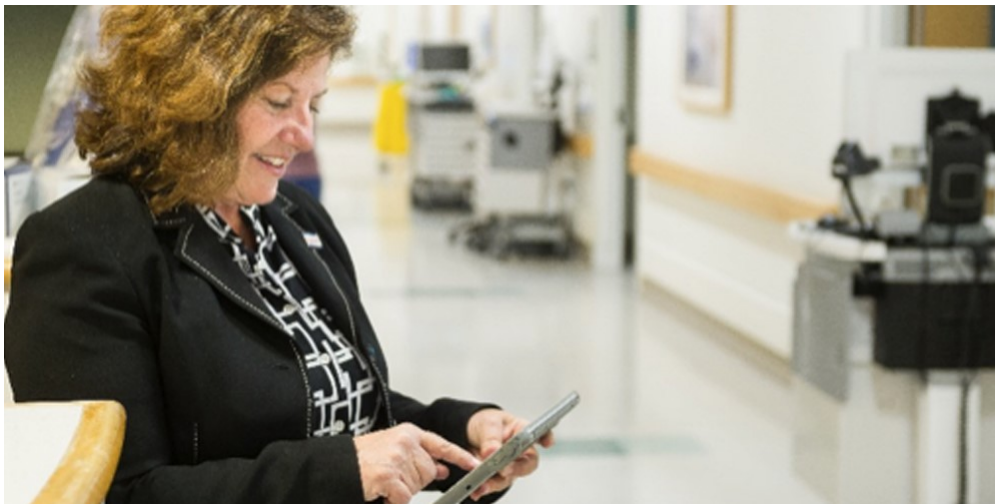

## Ensure You Are Using Your VA-issued iOS Devices Securely

VA care teams that have received a VA-issued iOS device should take the recommended Talent Management System (TMS) training titled, "Mobile Training: Security of Apps on iOS Devices (WBT)," in order to learn how to use their device and apps securely.

The training module teaches you how to:

- Properly protect VA information and information systems, especially the personal data of Veterans
- Learn how to securely use public apps that are downloaded from the Apple App Store
- Identify the difference between apps downloaded from the Apple App Store versus the VA App Catalog
