

WHAT IS EXPOSURE ED?

Exposure Ed provides comprehensive information about exposures and serves as a guide for discussing exposure-related concerns with Veterans.



- The app is available for VA and non-VA providers.
- It is accessible on iOS and Android devices.



HOME SCREEN



Access the app's main features from the Home screen:

- **Exposures** – Search for or choose from a list of exposures that Veterans may have encountered.
- **Date/Location** – A search feature that allows you to narrow exposure possibilities by date and location.
- **Conflicts** – A list of conflicts and the exposures most common to each conflict.

View information on a specific exposure:

- Tap **Exposures** on the Home screen
- You can search for an exposure by scrolling down the list and tapping the exposure you would like to learn more about or by typing the exposure name in the search field.
- Tap the category of information you would like to view.

AGENT ORANGE

- Description

One of several blends of tactical herbicides [equal amounts of 2,4-dichlorophenoxyacetic acid (2,4-D) and 2,4,5-trichlorophenoxyacetic acid (2,4,5-T), which contained traces of 2,3,7,8-tetrachlorodibenzo-p-dioxin (TCDD)] the U.S. military sprayed to remove trees and dense tropical foliage that provided enemy cover.

SEARCH BY DATE/LOCATION



EXPOSURE ED

DATE/LOCATION

ENTER YEAR
OR YEAR
RANGE
(Required)
Examples: 1990, or < 1990, or > 1990, or 1990 - 1991, etc.

CHOOSE LOCATION... (REQUIRED)

North America -- USA


SEARCH

Filter by date and location:

- Tap **Date/Location** on the Home screen.
- Enter the date or date range into the Enter Year or Year Range field.
- Tap the circle next to the location you would like to search.
- Tap **Search**.
- Two categories will appear - an Exposures list and VA Policies & Programs.



SEARCH BY CONFLICT




Some exposures are commonly associated with certain conflicts. To see what exposures might be related to a Veteran's service:

- Tap **Conflicts** on the Home screen.
- Tap the specific conflict to learn more.
- View an exposures list and VA Policies & Programs.



NOTES




Add exposure information to notes to share with patients:

- To view notes, tap **Menu** at the bottom of your screen, and tap **Notes**.
- View finished and unfinished notes.
- View a print preview or print/email finished notes.




VA LOCATOR



- Find local VA facilities
- Tap Menu, and then tap VA Locator
- Tap Search locations by address, zip, and/or facility type
- Search for a facility from the VA locator website

- Tap the tip you would like to view:
