- The app is available for VA and non-VA providers.
- It is accessible on iOS and Android devices.

Access the app's main features from the Home screen:

- **Exposures** Search for or choose from a list of exposures that Veterans may have encountered.
- Date/Location A search feature that allows you to narrow exposure possibilities by date and location.
- Conflicts A list of conflicts and the exposures most common to each conflict.

View information on a specific exposure:

- Tap **Exposures** on the Home screen
- You can search for an exposure by scrolling down the list and tapping the exposure you would like to learn more about or by typing the exposure name in the search field.
- Tap the category of information you would like to view.
